## 2011 SAPEN Conference Presenters

**Jennifer Caramenico, MA, L.P.C.**, is a clinical therapist and the project coordinator for the Ravenhill Psychological Services of Edison Court, Inc. As the project coordinator she is responsible for project development and the oversight of community outreach. She provides outpatient and inpatient therapy to children, adolescents and families in addition to providing clinical reports to courts and probation/parole officials regarding treatment recommendations, client progress and prognosis.

**Dr. Grace McGorrian** is a noted Psychiatrist with significant experience working in the adult and juvenile correctional field. She is board certified in Adult Psychiatry, the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology, 1989; Geriatric Psychiatry, American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology, 1996-2006; Forensic Psychiatry, American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology, 2005.

**Pamela J. Pillsbury, MA**, is currently the Co-Director for the Pennsylvania Regional Center for Public Safety Innovation. She has provided trainings in the area of human trafficking in Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Delaware and Maryland. Additionally, she coordinates and trains law enforcement and community members in a variety of trainings that include Domestic Violence, Human Trafficking, Community Policing, Diversity, Ethics for Law Enforcement, Volunteers in Police Service, Problem Solving and Anti-Terrorism.

**Megan Black, J.D.**, is an Assistant District Attorney for Allegheny County. She currently prosecutes juvenile delinquency matters in the Juvenile Section of the Family Division. She is responsible for all aspects of trial preparation, including reviewing charges, filing motions, interviewing victims and witness, coordinating discovery materials, negotiating plea agreements when appropriate and litigating bench trials.

**Special Services Unit**, The Special Services Unit (SSU) was created in 1985 by Allegheny County Juvenile Court to provide intensive supervision and specialized treatment services for adjudicated sexual offenders. A supervisor, two community-based Probation Officers and three Aftercare probation Officers staff the SSU.

**Cindy King, LCSW, LISW-S**, is a licensed in the State of Pennsylvania as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) and in Ohio as a Licensed Independent Social Worker-Supervisor (LISW-S). She is a social worker in a private practice with over 22 years of experience specializing in the assessment and treatment of juvenile and adult sex offenders, sexually reactive youth and victims of sexual abuse and their families. She is the President of King and Associates, Inc., training and consulting company that provided skill-building training to mental health professionals, caseworkers, police officers, probation officers and teachers. She is the former Executive Director of the Jefferson County Children Services Board and is currently on the Governor's Sex Offender Assessment Board in Pennsylvania. She is also on the Attorney General's list of expert witnesses for child welfare cases within the state of Ohio.

**Deborah Slates-Ciocco, MA**, is a Probation Officer and the PTSD Project Coordinator for the Westmoreland County Juvenile Probation Department. She has been certified as a trainer in many areas, a few of these being the F.B.I., the Municipal Police Officers Training Academy in Pennsylvania, and the Posttraumatic Stress Disorder project through the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency. As part of the PTSD Project she also has been certified in facilitation of the PTSD Residential treatment Curriculum.
